

Sea Angling Diary Project 2019 – Sign Up Prize Draw Terms and Conditions

1. These terms and conditions apply to the above prize draw run by Substance, a company limited by shares, number 09170484. Any questions about the competition or these Terms and Conditions should be addressed to: Substance, Canada House, Chepstow St, Manchester M1 5FW.
2. The Terms and Conditions supersede any previous Terms and Conditions set.
3. By entering the competition you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions.
4. No donation to Substance is necessary in order to enter the competition or be considered for the prize.
5. The competition is open to all UK residents aged 18 years or older and by entering the competition you confirm that you are 18 years or older.
6. All those signing up to participate in the Sea Angling Diary 2019 will qualify for the draw. This includes existing participants who confirm sign up for 2019.
7. The closing date for entries is January 15th 2019.
8. The winner will be selected at random by Substance no later than the 31st January 2019. The winner will be notified by email within 28 working days of the competition closing date.
9. If a winner does not claim the prize within 28 days of being notified, or if a winner is not available to take up the prize, Substance reserves the right to award the prize to another entrant without liability to the winner.
